### **Practice Membership**

The practice membership is a registration system for practices. To be eligible, the candidate organisation must have at least one Corporate Member of the ILI. Practice membership permits practices to have details of their company on our database and on our website. It allows your practice details, direct email and weblink to be posted in the **'Find a Landscape Architect / Members by Location'** section of the ILI website. This allows the ILI to ensure that we are fully knowledgeable of the professional practice of our members and to promote the profession accordingly. It also allows us to provide the best service to our membership. This is an invaluable advertising /marketing tool for our private practice members as well as being cost effective particularly in the current economic climate. It should be noted that the Irish Landscape Institute is the first website to appear when googling 'Landscape Architecture in Ireland'. Practice membership also entitles member organisations to discounts on advertising of vacancies, notices in Landscape Ireland or the ILI website.

### **Practice Fees – New Structure**

The following practice fee structure will apply from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2009. The aim of these revisions are to consolidate fees in an equitable manner, ensuring that sole practitioners and smaller practices can continue to support and be part of the Irish Landscape Institute in the current economic climate. Fees for Corporate, Graduate and Student Membership will remain unchanged this year. We are however introducing an 'Affiliate' Membership Category to increase our general membership, particularly from the public sector and related professions. Also, given the increased number of redundancies in the Landscape Architectural Industry in the last seven months, we have also introduced an 'Unwaged' category, for those Landscape Architects who are currently experiencing unemployment.

Please note that in **Category A : Sole Practitioner, and Category B : Small Practice**, the practice fee includes for the Corporate Membership fee for 1 Principal Landscape Architect only. All other fully qualified Landscape Architects are required to pay the full Corporate Membership fee.

This facility will be available to fully paid practices only and reviewed annually.

**Category A : Sole Practitioner 1 Principal Landscape Architect**

Fee : € 270

( Formerly €185 (practice fee) + €170 (corporate membership fee) = €370. Saving of €100)

Inclusive of Corporate Membership for 1 Principal Landscape Architect only

**Category B : Small Practice 1-3 Landscape Architects**

Fee : €320

( Formerly €235. Saving of €100)

Inclusive of Corporate Membership for 1 Principal Landscape Architect only

**Category C : Medium Practice 1 – 7 Landscape Architects**

Fee : €435

( Formerly €335. Increase of €100)

Note : Practice Fee only. Full Corporate Membership to be paid separately

**Category D : Large Practice 1 – 12 Landscape Architects**

Fee : €560

( Formerly €460. Increase of €100)

## **Category E : Large Practice      Greater than 12 Landscape Architects**

Fee : €685

( Formerly €535. Increase of €150)
