- Question A1.** Set out and briefly explain the main Work Stages which you would use to structure a proposal for a landscape consultancy project from inception to completion on-site.
- Question A2.** List the five 'Objects' for which the Irish Landscape Institute was established as contained in the Memorandum of Association.
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SECTION B - Environmental and Landscape-related Legislation and Law

- Question B1.** You are leading the environmental impact assessment process for a new building development. Describe the place of mitigation in the process and the strategies you could apply for mitigation of impacts to the baseline landscape.
- Question B2.** A planning authority has granted permission for a new development which required an EIS. List all categories of stakeholders who could be entitled to appeal the decision to An Bord Pleanála under the Planning and Development Act 2000? Briefly outline the reasons for each stakeholder's entitlement.
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SECTION C - Contract

- Question C1.** As defined under the Safety, Health and Welfare Act 2005 and the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (Construction) Regulations 2013, briefly describe the main responsibilities of the Project Supervisor for the Design Process and the Project Supervisor for the Construction Stage.
- Question C2.** Describe the main differences in tendering procedures for a landscape works contract in the private sector, compared with the public sector (prior to tender award). In your answer, refer to the process of shortlisting suitable contractors and selection of the appropriate form of contract.
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
