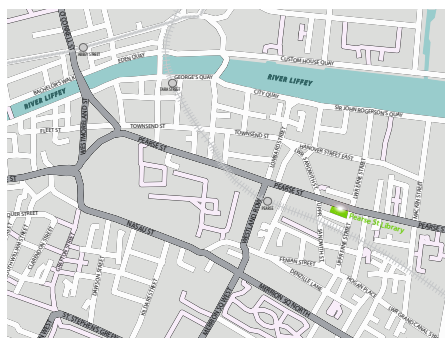
DESIGN METHODS IN PRACTICE

Andrew Griffin, JDS Architects , Copenhagen

Andrew is a director in JDS Architects, leading the Copenhagen office. JDS Architects is a multidisciplinary office that focuses on architecture and design, from large scale planning to furniture. The design approach of JDS is to turn intense research and analysis of practical and theoretical issues into the driving forces of their design. The practice has obtained numerous honours and awards for their work such as the Maaskant Prize 2009, three Mies van der Rohe nominations, a Golden Lion at the 2004 Venice Biennale, the World Architecture Festival Award 2009 for Best Housing, the AR+D Award, and two Forum Prizes for best Nordic project. Andrew graduated from the Dublin School of Architecture DIT and has worked for OMA in Rotterdam, FKL Architects in Dublin and PLOT in Copenhagen. He has won the inaugural EUROPAN site in Dublin.
